TVA NUCLEAR (TVAN) ORGANIZATION TOPICAL REPORT - BELLEFONTE, BROWNS FERRY, SEQUOYAH, AND WATTS BAR NUCLEAR PLANTS

Enclosed is the revised topical report which incorporates organizational changes that have been announced through June 27, 1997.

Revision 7 to the TVAN organization topical report describes the organizations responsible for the management and operation of TVA's nuclear projects. The primary revisions include: 1) the changes in Watts Bar organization due to completion of startup activities; 2) the continued standardization of organizations at the operating sites; and 3) the further consolidation of TVAN functions to align TVAN's Corporate functions and organization. This ensures enhanced service and support to the nuclear sites and efficient and effective delivery of that support. TVA is currently evaluating additional standardization at its operating sites in an effort to further improve the organization's effectiveness and efficiency.
