SUBJECT: WEEKLY SUMMARY OF NRC ACTIVITIES INVOLVING TVA
FEBRUARY 10-14, 1986

The following activities involving TVA were conducted by the NRC staff during the week ending February 14, 1986. These activities are listed under the NRC office having lead responsibility for a particular activity.

I. Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation (NRR)

2/10 NRR, IE, Region II, and the TVA Oversight Group participated in the weekly conference call with TVA representatives to review the status of ongoing activities. TVA announced that the submittal of the revision to Volume 1 (Corporate Nuclear Performance Plan) will be delayed until early March. This has a direct impact on staff review of corporate management changes. TVA also stated that submittals regarding the Watts Bar weld inspection program, NSRS concerns, and changes to the employee concern program could be expected within a few days.

TVA also stated that the Rockbestos cable testing appears to be successful and that the high energy line break issue may be resolved in the near term.


