The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Public Scoping Meeting on Environmental Issues Pertaining to the Proposed Combine License Application for North Anna Power Station, Unit 3

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is gathering information necessary to prepare an environmental impact statement (EIS) in support of the proposed combine license (COL) for North Anna Power Station, Unit 3.

The NRC is holding a public meeting to help identify significant environmental issues related to the COL proposed to be located at the North Anna Power Station near Mineral, Virginia. In addition, the meeting will provide an opportunity for interested members of the public to submit comments or suggestions on the proposed scope of the staff's environmental review.

This meeting will be preceded by a 1-hour open house during which members of the public may meet with NRC staff members.
