dated June 14, 1985. Below is our supplemental response to the deviation.


As discussed with NEC-OIE Region II Inspector A. Ignatoniis on July 29, 1985,
the date of July 28, 1985 for completion of corrective actions indicated in
our response on this matter was not met. The Safety Evaluation Report (SER)
review was more extensive than initially anticipated. As such, additional
time is needed to complete the review. The corrective action on this matter
will be completed by August 30, 1985.
