Section 657 of the Energy Policy Act of 2005 requires that before issuing a license for a utilization facility, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has to consult with the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) concerning potential vulnerabilities of the location of the proposed facility to terrorist attack. DHS has implemented a program to fulfill this responsibility that consists of a documentation review of previous assessments conducted at or in the vicinity of the proposed facility, an on-site review, and an interview of the local law enforcement agency (ies) that would respond to the proposed facility during an emergency situation. DHS has 90 working days to complete their review and submit a report to NRC.

Recognizing that NRC has notified you by letter dated January 28, 2008 that it has completed its acceptance review of your application and has determined it is acceptable for docketing, we would like to schedule a site visit for April 9, 2008. The purpose of the visit is to gain familiarization with the proposed site, and to collect data that could not be obtained through available documentation. The visit will consist of a tour of the site, the surrounding owner controlled area (excluding an existing Protected Area, if the proposed facility is co-located with an operating reactor), and any supporting infrastructure, such as cooling water sources, that are relevant to the operation of the proposed facility. To facilitate our visit we would like to have an escort that is familiar with reactor operations and the impact on operations resulting from the loss of supporting infrastructure. Finally, since some of the information may be Safe Guards, the following people can be verified through the Nuclear Regulatory Commission prior to our visit.
