This letter confirms verbal authorization provided to Parameter, Inc. on June 14, 1993 to modify the subject task order to change key personnel under the subject task order.

This action is taken in accordance with Section 6.5, Task Order Procedures, of the subject contract. R. Gilbert hereby replaces T. Childress under this task as key personnel. The Contractor agrees that such personnel shall not be removed from the effort under the task order without compliance with Contract Clause H.1, Key Personnel.

Because of the change in key personnel, the contractor did incur addition cost in the amount of \$4,200.00 for travel expenses. The traveler shall not exceed that amount without prior approval of the contracting officer. Therefore the ceiling is being revised from \$271,683.25 by \$4,200.00 to \$275,883.25. The amount of \$269,324.37 represents the estimated reimbursable costs, the amount of \$407.99 represents the facilities capital cost of money, and the amount of \$6,150.89 represents the fixed fee.
