Dear Mrs. Young:

I am writing to acknowledge your request to Representative Bart Gordon of the U.S. House of Representatives for any evaluations issued by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) for the Sequoyah Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2, and the Watts Bar Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2. Recently, the project managers for these plants contacted you to explain that copies of these evaluations (which number in the hundreds) would be voluminous and probably would occupy several bookshelves. Included among these are safety evaluations on various aspects of plant design, inspection reports, and systematic assessment of licensee performance reports. Thus, the project managers asked if there were any specific issues that you are interested in for which evaluations could be sent. You stated that you did not need any specific evaluations at this time.

In their discussions with you, the project managers explained the relationship of the NRC staff and inspectors, the Institute of Nuclear Power Operations (INPO) inspectors, and the licensee's staff at the plants. They explained that any INPO evaluation reports are kept only at the plant site and are not distributed to the NRC. Therefore, we cannot provide you with copies.

Copies of all the evaluations of these plants issued by the NRC staff are in the local public document room. The local public document room for both Sequoyah and Watts Bar is located in the Chattanooga-Hamilton County Library at 1001 Broad Street, Chattanooga, Tennessee. You may use this library to read or obtain a copy of any evaluation that we have issued on these plants. We would be glad to send you a computer-generated listing of all evaluations issued by the NRC staff. This listing would be useful in helping you identify which specific evaluation you want.
