FFD Performance Data Review/Comments:

1. Were any events reported: On June 26, 2008 at approximately 1118 hours, a random drug and alcohol test indicated the presence of alcohol for a station manager (Senior Reactor Operator licensed). Test results indicated a BAC level of .013. The worker's access was suspended, an evaluation was completed, and the worker returned to work on July 11, 2008 (EN 44319).

- On March 31, 2008 (1) contractor employee tested positive for alcohol during a for-cause test
- On June 12, 2008 (1) licensee employee tested positive for marijuana during a random test
