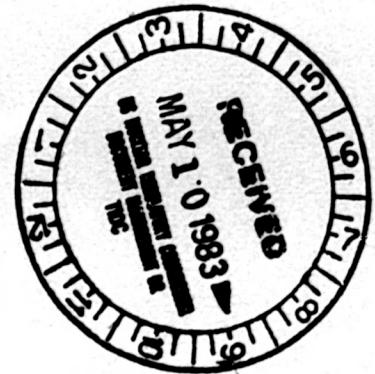

Dear Sir:

Reference (a) requires in part, "Prior to startup after the first refueling outage, the licensee shall provide adequate separation or barriers between Class 1E and adjacent non-Class 1E cable trays."

As a result of ongoing telecons with Dr. A. Bournia and Mr. John Knox of your staff, Commonwealth Edison Company agreed to perform verification testing of the adequacy of separation between Class 1E and non-Class 1E Power Cable in Raceways. Reference (b), (c), (d), and (e) provided documentation of the agreements and transmittals of test plans and procedures, which the NRC staff reviewed and approved.

The purpose of this letter is to provide you with the successful results of this test program, as documented in Wyle Test Report No. 46511-3, "Test Report on Verification Testing of Separation between Class 1E and non-Class 1E Power Cables in Raceways." It is our understanding

that, upon completion of your review of this report, all open issues on this subject have been resolved. It is therefore requested that the NRC provide Commonwealth Edison with written documentation of your closure of License NPF-11, Condition 2.C.(24).

To the best of my knowledge and belief the statements contained herein and in the enclosure are true and correct. In some respects these statements are not based upon my personal knowledge but upon information furnished by other Commonwealth Edison employees and consultants. Such information has been reviewed in accordance with Company practice and I believe it to be reliable.
