WATTS BAR NUCLEAR PLANT UNITS 1 AND 2 - NRC-OIE REGION II INSPECTION REPORT 50-390/82-20 AND 50-391/82-20 - SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE TO DEVIATIONS 390,391/82-20-01

The subject inspection report cited TVA with four deviations. Our responses were submitted December 16, 1982. A supplemental response was submitted on January 31, 1983. In that supplemental response TVA committed to complete the corrective actions as specified for the subject deviation by March 31, 1983.

As discussed with NRC-OIE Inspector P. Fredrickson on March 30-31, 1983, the date of March 31, 1983 for completion of the corrective actions was not met. Reinspection identified two dampers which did not bear the mark number as depicted on their applicable drawings. However, it was determined that these dampers provide a lequate protection; thus the drawings will be revised to reflect the mark numbers of the dampers as-installed. Also, one additional damper requiring replacement has been found (in addition to the three mentioned in our previous submittal). The corrective actions on this matter will be completed by April 30, 1983.
