I am making a Freedom of Information Act request for the following documents:

-- A Copy of the NRC Office of Enforcement's 10-3-88 proposal to the commissioners that recommended a \$160,000 fine for the Tennessee Valley Authority because their nuclear manager, Steven White, made several inaccurate, written sworn statements to the NRC regarding quality assurance at the Watts Bar Nuclear Plant.

-- A copy of the written record of how the commissioners voted on the previously mentioned Office of Enforcement proposal, and any written notations or comments by the commissioners about why they voted to reject the proposed fine and accept the other findings of the NRC staff. The commission's decision on the matter was announced publicly Oct. 21 by NRC's public affairs director, Joseph Fouchard.

This information will be used in the public interest -- perhaps in a newspaper story -- so I ask that you waive any copying or search fees, as the FOIA law allows. Thanks for your help.
