Kathy, I think we have some confusion on cross references regarding Comment 13 of your letter dated March 12, 2008.

The regulation below is what we have currently for 335.5010(a) which dereferences 335.30 (not 335.50 as noted in your letter). Below that we have the 335.30 that was included in the latest packet we sent you. This includes the 330.260(c) that you are looking for. So this correctly includes the reference that you are after. We simply decided to include all our manufacturing references in one section to streamline the rulemaking process. Both of these are final in Illinois

Please let me know if you concur on this.

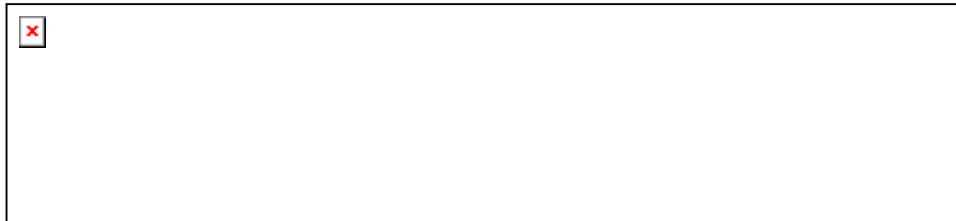

SECTION 335.5010 USE OF UNSEALED RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL FOR WHICH A WRITTEN
DIRECTIVE IS REQUIRED**

Section 335.5010 Use of Unsealed Radioactive Material for Which a Written Directive is Required

A licensee may use any unsealed radioactive material prepared for medical use and for which a written directive is required that is:

- a) Obtained from a person specified in Section 335.30 of this Part, or equivalent U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Agreement State or Licensing State requirements;

PART 335 MEDICAL USE OF RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL
SECTION 335.30 LICENSE REQUIRED**

Section 335.30 License Required

- a) A person may only use radioactive material or a radioactive sealed source for medical use that is:
 - 1) manufactured, produced, acquired, received, possessed, prepared or transferred in accordance with a specific license issued by the Agency in accordance with 32 Ill. Adm. Code 330.260(c), 330.280(i)-(k) or 330.280(n) or the equivalent regulations of the Agency, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, an Agreement State or a Licensing State, or as allowed in subsection (b)(1) or (b)(2) of this Section; or
 - 2) noncommercially transferred as sealed sources or devices from a facility licensed in accordance with this Part.
