This letter provides notification that we have completed all of the commitments outlined in Sections V.1-4 in the Confirmatory Order dated July 13, 2007, which were agreed to in an Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) session held on May 17, 2007 between the University of Pittsburgh and the NRC.

The lecture on NRC regulatory requirements at our UPMC Gamma Stereotactic Radiosurgery (GSR) training course has been expanded to include the physical presence requirements and a description of our experience in assuring compliance with this regulation. A lessons-learned article has been submitted to the Operational Radiation Safety (ORS) publication and the Elekta Newsletter, eWavelength, describing these events that led to the ADR. Copies of the submission documentation are attached. We have received notification that the article has been accepted for publication in ORS, but have not heard back from Elekta.
