RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL PACKAGES NO. 0898, REVISION 1

Dear Mr. Stein:

This letter is to inform you that your Quality Assurance (QA) Program Approval 71-0898, Revision 1, expired on August 31, 2008. The U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) policy does not allow for QA program approval to a non-certificate of compliance holder. In addition, 10 CFR Part 71 has no requirement for Agreement State licensees to obtain or hold an NRC QA approval of their QA program. Although some QA programs were previously approved by the NRC, the only QA program approvals required by 10 CFR Part 71 are for NRC licensees, Certificate of Compliance holders, and applicants for a Certificate of Compliance. Therefore, your QA program approval is hereby terminated and you are no longer authorized to procure, maintain, repair, or use radioactive material packagings, under this docket number, in accordance with 10 CFR Part 71.

Please note that records required by 10 CFR 71.91 and 71.135 are to be retained for a period of three years.
