Fitness for Duty Program Six Month Performance Report January – June 2008

PROGRAM SUMMARY:

The River Bend Nuclear Station annual random testing rate is 50 percent. During this reporting period, approximately 31.50 percent of the population has been randomly tested. The rate of positive tests from random testing is 0 percent. The total random percentage for the year is 31.50 percent.

POSITIVE RESULTS:

During this six month reporting period 890 samples were collected and tested. One individual's test result was confirmed positive. One individual refused to be tested resulting in the sanctions of a positive test.

- One "Other" test was administered on a Contractor employee due to out-of-range temperature administered during the Pre-Access drug test; result came back positive for marijuana. Subject was denied unescorted access.
- One follow-up test was refused by a Contractor employee. Subject was denied unescorted access.

MANAGEMENT ACTIONS:

There were 11 for-cause tests conducted this period:

- One Licensee employee was for-cause tested due to post-accident; result came back negative.
- Six Contractor employees were for-cause tested due to observed behavior; all had negative results.
- Four Contractor employees were for-cause tested due to post-accident; all had negative results.

Fourteen "Other" tests were conducted during this period. As stated above, one "Other" test result came back positive for marijuana. The remaining thirteen "Other" tests were due to out-of-range creatinine and came back with negative results.

EVENTS REPORTED TO THE NRC:

During this reporting period, there were no violations of the fitness for duty program that were reportable.

PROGRAM EVALUATION:

No programmatic problems were identified during this reporting period.
