By application dated August 18, 2008, Secured Transportation Services requested an approval of a route to transport spent fuel from McMaster University to Savannah River Site. This request identifies additional information needed by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff in connection with its review of the application. This request describes information needed by the staff for it to complete its review of the application and to determine whether the applicant has demonstrated compliance with regulatory requirements.

1. Verify and re-submit the route summary information in your proposed route application from McMaster University to Savannah River Site.

The route information in Mileage Route Summary page and the Virginia State page are inconsistent. Routes used for road shipments of spent fuel must be approved in advance in accordance with Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* Part 73.37.
