The subject deficiency was initially reported to NRC-OIE Inspector M. J. Gouge on January 3, 1980 in accordance with 10 CFR 50.55(e). On January 31, 1980 we submitted a final report; on May 20, 1980 we submitted a revised response; and on July 18, 1980 our revised final report was submitted. On February 10, April 9, and September 7, 1982, we submitted supplemental information reports.

As discussed with NRC-OIE Inspector P. Frederickson by telephone on December 1 1982, the date of November 30, 1982 for completion of corrective actions indicated in our last report for unit 1 was not met because of unanticipated field fabrication problems. The corrective action on this matter for unit 1 will be completed by January 15, 1983.
