
Subject: Response to Question Regarding Emergency Instructions for Field Support Personnel Operating Under SAIC Service License 04-27788-01

Per our phone discussion on September 10, 2008, I am sending this follow up clarification regarding emergency instructions to SAIC field support personnel operating under our NRC Service License 04-27788-01.

Field support personnel are instructed that if an off normal condition occurs with the SAIC products, they are to help the end user/licensee ensure, to the extent practical, that the source is in a safe/closed condition per the instructions in the Operating Manual, that the area is secured from unauthorized access and posted accordingly, and that the end user/ licensee's RSO is notified.
