3 we're satisfied at this point, Your Honor.

4 JUDGE SPRITZER: Okay. And, finally, the
5 NRC Staff, anything else that we need to talk about
6 today?

7 MS. BROCK: We have nothing to add.

8 JUDGE SPRITZER: All right. Well, I guess
9 this will be a short call then. I guess it's -- since
10 you all were able to reach agreement, we don't need to
11 keep you on the phone any longer. We'll try and get
12 an order out shortly.

13 Let me just ask the Staff, on the second
14 paragraph, the deadline for disclosure, does that also
15 cover -- I believe there's a provision in Subpart L
16 that says the "Staff is to produce the hearing file."
17 Is that also to be covered by the October 1st, 2008
18 deadline for initial disclosures?

19 MS. BROCK: We were certainly assuming
20 that. We probably should have added a citation to
21 that, as well.

1 there seems to be some sort of overlap between 336 and
2 the provision in Part L for the disclosure of the
3 hearing file. Okay. That's what I assumed. I just
4 wanted to be clear on that. So everyone will make
5 their initial disclosures by October 1st.

6 The only other thing we would add is,
7 while we don't see the need to add any further
8 deadlines than those that are included here, there are
9 some other matters that might conceivably come up
10 during this proceeding, and just bear in mind the
11 milestones that are in the - what is it, Appendix E,
12 to the extent they're not covered by our scheduling
13 order. That is, we would -- if something is filed
14 that's not covered by our scheduling order, you can
15 expect that we will give a good deal of weight to the
16 time periods that are in the milestones.

17 Any questions? Anything further anybody
18 wants to mention?

19 MR. LEWIS: No, sir.

20 JUDGE SPRITZER: Okay. And we will get a
21 ruling out shortly on the Motion for Reconsideration.
22 Very good. Well, thank you for your time, and your
23 efforts in submitting the proposed schedule. That
24 makes everyone's life a lot easier.


