Dear Mr. Paplauskas:

This is in reference to our 2007 Financial Assurance Audit of your financial assurance for Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 06-13022-02. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

A review of your license, during the audit, determined that you are permitted to possess an unlimited amount of licensed material in the form of sealed sources for your Cesium-137 irradiators (Item 8.K.). Maintaining this possession limit would require you to perform a Decommissioning Funding Plan (DFP), submit the plan to the NRC for review, and following the regulations pertaining to DFP in 10 CFR 30.36. Alternatively, you may amend your license limiting your possession of Cesium-137 in Item 6.K. using this open licensing action.
