SUBJECT: APPLICATION FOR A NEW LICENSE, HARTFORD CARDIOLOGY

Chelsey,

I reviewed the July 25, 2008 letter and forms you sent, but the all the information requested still has not been sent; forms are not completed. As I said in an earlier email, Dr. Knox appears to be using the NRC Form 313A (RSO) Option 3 to qualify as an RSO. All the Part and Section numbers below refer to Form 313A (RSO). I am sending a formal letter also, but in case you want to get started, here is what I have, and what is missing:

Part I, 3.a. was submitted with the July 9 letter, and is acceptable.

Part I, 3.b, first page, was submitted with the July 25 letter, and is acceptable.

Part I, 3.b, second page (at the top of the next page, above the beginning of 3.c) is not completed in any submission.

- The supervising RSO for the supervised experience must be named
- the license number on which the supervising RSO is named as an RSO must be listed
- appropriate boxes must be checked indicating the medical uses listed on the license for the supervising RSO

Part 1, 3.c, first page (at bottom of page that starts with 3.b supervising RSO), was submitted with the July 9 letter, and is acceptable

Part 1. 3.c, second page (at top of the next page, above the beginning of Part II - Preceptor Attestation) is not completed.

- the supervising individual must be listed
- the license number on which the supervising individual is authorized must be listed

- a box must be checked indicating if the supervising user is an RSO, AU, ANP or AMP, AND  
- appropriate boxes must be checked indicating what medical uses the supervising individual is authorized to perform

Part II - Preceptor Attestation is not completed. This must be completed and signed by the preceptor. there can be multiple preceptors but Thomas Knox cannot be his own preceptor, and that is whose signature is on the bottom of the incompleted form sent with the July 9 letter. There was no Preceptor Attestation in the July 25 letter.

- First Section - the preceptor must check the option that he is attesting the proposed RSO be qualified under (in this case, box 2 "Strucured Educational Program..." and must fill in the blank.

- Second Section - the preceptor must check the box attesting to the training in rad safety, regulations, and emergency procedures, filling in the blank and checking the box for the appropriate medical uses.

- Third Section - the preceptor must check the box and fill in the blank attesting to their belief that the propose RSO is sufficiently knowledgeable to function as an RSO for the proposed medical uses.

- Fourth Section - the preceptor must verify who he/she is by  
--- stating the name of the facility for which he/she is an RSO  
--- providing the license number on which he/she is an RSO  
--- printing his/her name  
--- signing his/her name  
--- providing a telephone number, AND  
--- writing the date when the Preceptor Attestation is signed.

Again, this information must be received in hard copy with actual signatures; a letter or facsimile is acceptable, but NOT email for this response. a hard copy letter requesting this information is being mailed today to Dr. Knox's attention.
