Dear Mr. McKinley:

The NRC was previously notified in a letter from R. Brent Rawlings, Esquire, dated July 15, 2008, of changes in the ownership and control of the licensee The Retreat Hospital, located in Richmond, Virginia (License Number 45-15048-01). Effective August 1, 2008, the assets of The Retreat Hospital were transferred from Retreat Hospital, Inc. (the “Transferor”) to HCA Health Services of Virginia, Inc. (the “Transferee”), the parent of Retreat Hospital, Inc. and owner of the licensees Henrico Doctors’ Hospital - Forest and Henrico Doctors’ Hospital – Parham, also located in Richmond, Virginia.

In accordance with NRC Information Notice 89-25, we are providing the following additional information:

- a. The Retreat Hospital is a campus of Henrico Doctors’ Hospital and its name has changed to “The Retreat Hospital - a campus of Henrico Doctors’ Hospital.”
- b. There have been no changes in personnel named in any license.
- c. The Transferor remains in business, but not as a hospital or licensee.
- d. Effective August 1, 2008, the assets of The Retreat Hospital were transferred from Retreat Hospital, Inc. to HCA Health Services of Virginia, Inc., parent of Retreat Hospital, Inc. and owner of the licensees Henrico Doctors’ Hospital - Forest and Henrico Doctors’ Hospital – Parham, also located in Richmond, Virginia.
- e. With the exception of some changes to the management staff and governing board of The Retreat Hospital, there have been no changes in organization, location, facilities, equipment, procedures, or personnel. There have been no changes in the location or transfer of any radiation machine or radioactive materials as a result of the restructuring.
- f. There have been no changes in the use, possession, or storage of any licensed materials or equipment.
- g. Surveillance items and records were current at the time of transfer and remain unchanged. Surveillance activity continues at regularly scheduled intervals.



To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is to notify the NRC of changes in the ownership and control of the licensee The Retreat Hospital, located in Richmond, Virginia (License Number 45-15048-01). Effective August 1, 2008, the assets of The Retreat Hospital will be transferred from its current owner, Retreat Hospital, Inc. (the “Transferor”) to HCA Health Services of Virginia, Inc. (the “Transferee”), the parent of Retreat Hospital, Inc. and owner of the licensees Henrico Doctors’ Hospital - Forest and Henrico Doctors’ Hospital – Parham, also located in Richmond, Virginia.

In accordance with NRC Information Notice 89-25, we are providing the following additional information:

- a. The Retreat Hospital will become a campus of Henrico Doctors’ Hospital and its name will change to “The Retreat Hospital - a campus of Henrico Doctors’ Hospital.”
- b. There will be no changes in personnel named in any license.
- c. The Transferor will remain in business, but not as a hospital or licensee.
- d. Effective August 1, 2008, the assets of The Retreat Hospital will be transferred from its current owner, Retreat Hospital, Inc. to HCA Health Services of Virginia, Inc., parent of Retreat Hospital, Inc. and owner of the licensees Henrico Doctors’ Hospital - Forest and Henrico Doctors’ Hospital – Parham, also located in Richmond, Virginia.
- e. With the exception of some changes to the management staff and governing board of The Retreat Hospital, there are no planned changes in organization, location, facilities, equipment, procedures, or personnel. There will be no change in the location or transfer of any radiation machine or radioactive materials as a result of the restructuring.

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- f. There are no planned changes in the use, possession, or storage of any licensed materials or equipment.
- g. Surveillance items and records will be current at the time of transfer and will remain unchanged. Surveillance activity will continue at regularly scheduled intervals.

- i. The facility will not be decommissioned as a result of the restructuring. All records concerning the safe and effective decommissioning of the facility will be transferred to the Transferee.
- j. The Transferor and Transferee have agreed to the transfer and ownership of control of the licensed material and activity to be effective as of August 1, 2008.
- k. The Transferee commits to abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments identified in the existing license.

Also, please let me know if any further action is required on behalf of the Transferor or Transferee at this time. We look forward to working with the NRC in coordinating the completion of any required forms or applications necessary for transfer of ownership and control of licensed activities as appropriate in connection with the restructuring.
