I will try going through Internet Explorer, but I want to make a formal request to extend the October 7th comment deadline to allow time for thoughtful comment on this very important document.

I have many questions having to do with potential impacts to fragile desert water systems and aquifers.

Environmental Justice concerns are also primary. Local tribal people who choose to live in their land in a traditional way are being subjected to removal or suffer possible effects of radioactive contamination. Past contamination of tribal peoples is well documented in the record.

I need more time to be able to access the DEIR and make more formal comments.

I therefore hereby ask for a 180-day extension of the October 7th deadline.
