SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF SEPTEMBER 11, 2008, PUBLIC MEETING WITH
INDUSTRY'S DESIGN-CENTERED WORKING GROUP TO DISCUSS
GENERIC ISSUES RELATED TO COMBINED LICENSE APPLICATIONS

On September 11, 2008, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held a Category 2 public meeting at the Legacy Hotel and Conference Centre in Rockville, Maryland to discuss generic issues of interest to industry as well as processes the NRC plans to employ in future combined license reviews. Topics discussed included license conditions, electronic submittals, first of a kind engineering inspection update, plant-specific technical specifications, army corps memorandum of understanding update, security reviews, security inspection, test, analysis, and acceptance criteria, supplemental interim staff guidance on limited work authorizations and the definition of construction, and Federal Emergency Management Agency issues (see meeting agenda, Agency Document Access Management Systems (ADAMS) accession no. ML082410094). Enclosure 1 lists the meeting attendees.

A follow-up public meeting will be scheduled to discuss security issues.
