Exelon Nuclear Texas Holdings, LLC (Exelon) submitted an application for a combined license (COL) in the referenced letter for Victoria County Station (VCS) Units 1 and 2. That submittal consisted of eleven parts as described in the referenced letter and a separate part containing Safeguards Information provided under separate cover.

In addition to the contents of the application, Exelon is also providing the enclosed supplemental information in support of the review of the VCS Units 1 and 2 COL application (COLA). The enclosed meteorological data CD-R, labeled, "Victoria County Station Units 1 and 2, Meteorological Data collected July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008," contains the specified 12 months of meteorological data collected at the VCS site, and is provided in electronic format on the enclosed disk. This data disk specifically provides an electronic sequential, hour-by-hour listing of the data set, in the format specified in Appendix A of Regulatory Guide 1.23, "Meteorological Monitoring Programs for Nuclear Power Plants," as described in the VCS COLA Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR) Section 2.3.3.6.5.

Two copies of the electronic data CD's are enclosed, one CD for submission to the Public Document Room (PDR) and one CD for NRC staff use. The content of this submittal has been previously discussed with the NRC staff, and an additional 12 months of meteorological data will be provided when available, as described in VCS COLA FSAR Section 2.3.3.6.5.


