Dear Dr. Cetintas:


In NRC form 314, "Certificate of Disposition of Materials" you contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate your NRC radioactive material license. Based on the NRC staff reviewed of your final status survey and most current NRC inspection dated October 25, 2007, which indicated your possession of two Troxler gauges, we conclude that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from your facility in NRC jurisdiction. It is our understanding that your use of licensed material will be limited to temporary job sites in the State of Ohio.

Based on these conclusions, no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. Your facility is suitable for unrestricted use and NRC license number 34-32658-01 is hereby terminated.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS).
