SUBJECT: Suspension of Stepan License STC-1333 in regards to Burial Pit 3

Dear Mr. McConnell:

This letter is a request in accordance with the Memorandum of Understanding between the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) for Coordination on Cleanup & Decommissioning of the Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program (FUSRAP) Sites with NRC-Licensed Facilities signed on 5 July 2001 (hereinafter "MOU"), to suspend the Stepan Company license, STC-1333, as it applies to that portion of the Stepan Company Maywood, NJ site known as "Burial Pit 3" on the enclosed site map. The licensee is Stepan Company, 22 W Frontage Road, Northfield, IL 60093. This request is made in accordance with Article III, Paragraph A of the MOU and satisfies all the requirements of the MOU and advises that USACE views the MOU and no other document as controlling in this matter.

USACE will take physical possession of Burial Pit 3 on the Stepan Company site on 17 November 2008 for purposes of control of radiation from FUSRAP materials subject to NRC jurisdiction and will be responsible for the protection of the public health and safety from those licensed materials consistent with 10 CFR Part 20, "Standards For Protection Against Radiation" and other requirements consistent with the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act of 1980, as amended (CERCLA). USACE will conduct a response action at Burial Pit 3 under its FUSRAP and CERCLA authority, with regard to FUSRAP materials subject to NRC jurisdiction, to meet at least the standards required under 10 CFR Part 20.1402, and USACE has no objection to, and will facilitate, NRC observing USACE in-process remediation activities.

USACE is prepared to begin remediation of the material in Burial Pit 3 and will do so on either 1 Dec 2008, or upon the receipt of notification from the NRC that the license in regards to Burial Pit 3 has been suspended, whichever comes later. This request has been coordinated with Mr. Robert Spencer, Facility Engineer, of the Stepan Company and the licensee consented to this schedule and to the suspension of the Stepan license in regards to Burial Pit 3 on 17 Nov 2008.
