- Part 11i – References


A second DVD containing non-redacted sensitive and non-public revised specific Parts to the COL application specified above is provided in Enclosure 2 (Non-Public Disk). We are requesting that the proprietary information in Part 1, Part 2, Part 3, Part 9, and Part 11h be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, "Public inspections, exemptions, request for withholding," paragraph (a)(4). This proprietary information is appropriately marked and an affidavit providing the basis for this request is provided in Enclosure 3. The COL application also contains sensitive, unclassified, non-safeguards information (SUNSI) that could be an aid to a potential adversary. As such, we are also requesting that the SUNSI in the above cited Parts be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390(d)(1). This SUNSI is appropriately marked.

Finally, appropriate pre-submission checks have been successfully performed on the COL application Revision 3 DVD files to ensure conformance with the electronic submittal guidelines provided on the NRC web site. Each DVD includes a "packing slip" describing its contents in accordance with NRC instructions for electronic submittals.

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
George Vanderheyden, being duly sworn, hereby deposes and states as follows:

1. My name is George Vanderheyden. I am the President and Chief Executive Officer for UniStar Nuclear Energy.
2. I have been authorized by UniStar Nuclear Energy to execute this affidavit in support of UniStar Nuclear Energy's request to withhold proprietary information identified in UniStar Nuclear Energy's letter to the NRC UN#08-025, "UniStar Nuclear Energy, Docket No. 52-016, Submittal of Revision 3 to the Combined License Application for the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant, Unit 3, and Application for Withholding Documents," hereafter referred to as the "Proprietary Information," from public disclosure in accordance with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) regulations appearing at 10 CFR § 2.390(a)(4).
3. The Proprietary Information is being submitted as proprietary and confidential information as part of an enclosure to UniStar Nuclear Energy's letter UN#08-025 from myself to NRC's Document Control Desk.
4. The Proprietary Information includes detailed financial information regarding costs and taxes associated with the construction and operation of the proposed U.S. EPR nuclear power plant at the Calvert Cliffs sites (i.e., Unit 3). The Proprietary Information also contains sensitive unclassified non-safeguards information.
5. The Proprietary Information was prepared with the explicit understanding that the information itself would be treated as proprietary and confidential. The information should therefore be withheld from public disclosure. Indeed, UniStar Nuclear Energy has refrained from publicly disclosing this information. To the best of my knowledge and belief, the Proprietary Information has not otherwise been knowingly made available in any public source.
6. If the Proprietary Information was publicly disclosed, UniStar Nuclear Energy would suffer irreparable and incalculable harm. Specifically, UniStar Nuclear Energy's competitors would gain valuable insight into otherwise unavailable business strategies, plans, and financial details. By knowing the details included in the Proprietary Information, UniStar Nuclear Energy's competitors would obtain an unfair commercial advantage that would significantly affect UniStar Nuclear Energy's ability to compete. In addition, the success of the UniStar Nuclear Energy's future plans is governed in large part by the cost and tax information, and thus to publicly disclose this information as reflected in Proprietary Information would result in substantial harm to the competitive position of UniStar Nuclear Energy.

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
7. Financial information by its nature is treated as confidential. The specific financial details in the Proprietary Information have not been publicly released for the reasons set forth above. Accordingly, withholding the Proprietary Information from disclosure will not adversely affect the public.

9. The Proprietary Information is being submitted to the NRC in confidence. The Proprietary Information is of a sort customarily held in confidence by UniStar Nuclear Energy, and in fact has been held in confidence and not otherwise previously publicly released.
