I have identified those items remaining in the Idaho facility from the list of items for re-survey. I have compiled the list of items which have been discarded, or unavailable and the reasons. Items identified for re-survey have been segregated for testing and have remained essentially untouched since the re-survey was planned. The re-survey is being performed today by Philotechnics, and when completed, I will submit the results of this testing, together with the equipment used, MDAs and release criteria.

>I wanted to let you know that the inspection report is going through
>final NRC management review. I will follow up with you when we are
>ready to issue it so that we can either FAX or send you an electronic
>copy.

>Since we have not spoken since the exit meeting on September 18, I was
>wondering if you could provide me with a status of the re-surveys of
>the 80 or so identified items. Did you compile a list of which items
>were no longer available to be re-surveyed and for what reason? Have
>the re-surveys been performed yet? If so, who performed the surveys,
>what equipment did they use, and what were their MDAs and release
>criteria? What were the results of the re-surveys? If the surveys
>have not yet been performed, please provide me with the scheduled
>date(s). As noted to you in an email on September 10, we expected that
>the re-surveys would be completed in the near term. This delay of time
>in providing the results to the NRC is excessive and unreasonable. Any
>status of your progress on this action would be appreciated.

>
>Also as noted to you earlier, you are requested to: (1) refrain from
>moving the identified items around or removing them from your facility,
>and (2) refrain from using or otherwise handling the identified items
>without appropriate precautions. Until the items are re-surveyed and
>appropriately released, it would be prudent to avoid any actions that
>could potentially result in radiological contamination of personnel, or
>the spread of radiological contamination within your facility or to
>off-site locations.
