Dear Ms. Rehmann:

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is pleased that you will participate in a public Commission meeting on uranium recovery regulation, Thursday, December 11, 2008. The meeting will be held in the Commissioners' Conference Room on the first floor of the NRC's Headquarters building at One White Flint North, Rockville, Maryland; it will have two parts. In the morning at 9:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m., the NRC staff will provide a presentation on (1) the status of in-situ leach (ISL) uranium recovery license applications, (2) the status of the draft Generic Environmental Impact Statement (GEIS) for ISL, and (3) the status of the cooperative rulemaking with the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) on groundwater protection at ISL uranium recovery facilities. During the afternoon you will be part of a broad spectrum of stakeholders. The Commission is interested in hearing about the role of IFSOUP, its plans, and its views on NRC's regulation of uranium recovery. I am enclosing a copy of the draft meeting agenda for your information (Enclosure 1). At this time, not all participants have been confirmed. My staff will keep you informed of updates to the agenda.

To assist the Commission in preparing for the meeting, please send a copy of any written material to Ms. Michelle Schroll in the Office of the Secretary, by December 4, 2008, so that it can be distributed to the Commission for review in advance of the meeting. If you intend to use viewgraphs, please notify Ms. Schroll as soon as possible, and follow the enclosed guidelines (Enclosure 2) which are designed for media streaming. Your presentation at the Commission meeting should be based on the assumption that Commissioners are familiar with the content of your written material. Please plan your oral presentation for 10 minutes or less, discussing the important points on which you wish to focus the Commission's attention.
