SUBJECT: RESPONSE TO NRC BULLETIN 87-02, SUPPLEMENTS 1 AND 2, "FASTENER TESTING TO DETERMINE CONFORMANCE WITH APPLICABLE SPECIFICATIONS"

NRC Bulletin 87-02 and Supplements 1 and 2 requested detailed information about the fasteners at your nuclear power facilities. Your responses dated March 16, 1988 and April 15, 1988 contained the information requested by the initial publication of Bulletin 87-02 for Sequoyah, Browns Ferry, Bellefonte and Watts Bar Nuclear Power Plants. The staff reviewed your submittal for the Browns Ferry Nuclear Power Plant (see enclosure) and it was acceptable. Your submittal for the Sequoyah Nuclear Power Plant was informally reviewed and also found to be acceptable.

Your responses dated July 6, 1988, and September 12, 1988 contained information about your suppliers of fasteners as requested by Supplements 1 and 2 to Bulletin 87-02. As agreed upon by NRC staff and TVA, the list of manufacturers of fasteners will be furnished early in 1989. To fully respond to the bulletin and its supplements, the addresses of the suppliers and manufacturers need to be provided, and an early 1989 date would be appropriate.
