WATTS BAR NUCLEAR PLANT UNITS 1 AND 2 - NO EVIDENCE THAT AUXILIARY
FEEDWATER PUMP COMPONENTS MEET CODE REQUIREMENTS, ASME CLASS 3, TVA CLASS C
- WBRD-50-390/82-31, WBRD-50-391/82-28 - FOURTH INTERIM REPORT

The subject deficiency was initially reported to NRC-OIE Inspector
R. V. Crlenjak on March 30, 1982 in accordance with 10 CFR 50.55(e) as NCR
3755R. Interim reports were submitted on May 11 and July 2, 1982 and
January 11, 1983. We expect to submit our next report on or about
September 27, 1983.

TVA is still in the process of investigating the subject deficiency. The
cause of this deficiency and actions necessary to prevent recurrence are being
determined. Design drawing revisions are complete and all components are
installed to TVA safety class C requirements for unit 1.

NRC-OIE Inspector Linda Watson was notified on June 28, 1983 concerning an error
in our third interim report dated January 11, 1983. We intended to submit this
report on or about July 22, 1983 and not July 1, 1983.
