On October 9, 2008, Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff met with representatives of the Electric Power Research Institute (EPRI), Westinghouse Electric Company, AREVA, FENOC, and other industry and utility representatives in a public meeting in Rockville, Maryland. The purpose of the meeting was to present and discuss research performed with the aim of developing a risk-informed basis for a revision of 10 CFR 50 Appendix G. The NRC staff (and their contractors) and industry representatives reviewed work performed since the previous meeting on August 21, 2008, including issues that arose out of the previous meeting.

The industry is working towards presenting their recommended risk-informed approach to specifying fracture toughness requirements in ASME Section XI Appendix G at the November 2008 ASME Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code meeting.
