Dear Sir or Madam:

This is a request for records under the Federal Freedom of Information Act.

I am interested in obtaining records in the possession of the Department of Justice, relating to the following:

- Certificates of Insurance issued by Lloyd's of London and other Underwriters (hereinafter referred to as "Lloyd's") during the 1950s and 1960s on policies payable to the Atomic Energy Commission, covering loss and damage from uranium held by and/or owned by the United States or other third-parties.
- Copies of the underlying insurance policies issued by Lloyd's.
- Documentation of claims for indemnification asserted by the United States under the insurance policies issued by Lloyds.


My understanding is that the Atomic Energy Commission requested demonstration of insurance coverage by Lloyd's for any and all third-parties managing, processing, storing, or refining uranium owned by the United States during the 1950s and 1960s. For your information, I have enclosed a representative Certificate of Insurance issued by Lloyd's on December 5, 1958.

I am interested in obtaining copies of all correspondence, historical research, and other records related to these matters in the possession of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. For your information, a similar FOIA request has been submitted to the Department of Justice, Civil Division.

If you make an initial determination that I do not qualify for an exemption from fees, I am willing to pay fees for this request up to a maximum of \$500.00. If you estimate that the fees will exceed this limit, please inform me of the estimated cost first.
