Enclosed please find the Acknowledgment Letter from the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) for the case referenced above.

Please note that the petition for review in this matter seeks review of an agency order (the NRC's joint denial of rulemakings PRM-51-10 and PRM 51-12) whose review is simultaneously being sought in an action that was filed in this Circuit on August 8, 2008 by the State of New York. That case is docket no. 08-3903-ag. The NRC has already filed a certified index of the record in that proceeding, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2112(a)(1). In addition, on September 30, 2008, the Commonwealth of Massachusetts filed a petition for review of the same NRC order in the First Circuit Court of Appeals. The First Circuit docket number for the latter case is 08-2267. The NRC plans to file a motion in the First Circuit to transfer that case to the Second Circuit pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2112(a)(5).
