SUBJECT
Control No. 317368 - Re request by letter dated 7-14-08 to seeking authorization to change film badges quarterly versus monthly.

SUMMARY
In the telephone conversation with Mr. Shively, we discussed that based on the exposure history information provided by a NVLAP approved processor for the recent six month period, demonstrating that annual doses for workers would be well below ten percent of the annual dose limits in 10 CFR 20.1201, this information could be maintained by the licensee as a basis for not monitoring individuals for radiation dose. Further, on that basis, if the licensee chooses to go ahead and provide personnel monitoring to workers, no justification would be needed for using quarterly vs. monthly exchange frequency of the monitoring device. Therefore, I noted we would add his letter dated 7-14-08 to the tie-down condition of the referenced license to accommodate his request.

I also noted that we are now required to place possession limits for each radionuclide authorized on a license, when processing a licensing action, if not already on the license. Mr. Shively requested a limit of 170 millicuries for Cs-137 and 850 millicuries for Am-241, be placed on the license.
