Hi Ron,

After our conversation earlier this week, I had a couple of more thoughts on the dryer particulate emissions. Here they are:

How is the dryer particulate issue being addressed in license applications or existing sites (i.e. New applications, existing operations at Smith-Highlands, Crow Butte, license issued to Crownpoint, ISR facilities in Texas (even though they are an agreement state they should follow NRC protocol)? Did everyone estimate a particulate source term? Is anyone monitoring the stack/vent? Is everyone monitoring the fence line (license boundary locations)?

These are just a couple of thoughts that I wanted to share with you. Also for the meeting on Wednesday could you bring a copy of the license application with you? I think that we should only need the Tech Report, Volume V and Va (Appendix D5 - Geology for the cross sections) and Volume VI and Va, Appendix D6.
