14:30 I left a message on Ms. Wood's voice-mail requesting that she contact me about some changes in possession limits required by the NRC's Office of the General Counsel (OGC).

13:00 I spoke with Ms. Wood about the request to amend the license to remove the irradiator sources from the license. I informed her that there were no questions regarding the irradiator sources. Items 8.F and G are the possession limits for the Nickel-63 and Cadmium-109 sources. Currently, they allow for an unlimited number of sources which, according to an interpretation of 10 CFR 30.210 by the OGC, is not allowed. I requested that she review her records and determine what would be an appropriate possession limit for the two authorizations. Ms. Wood stated that she would do so within the week.
