Based on discussions between Alpha-Omega Services, Inc (AOS), General Electric-Hitachi Nuclear Energy Americas, LLC (GE) and the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Spent Fuel Storage and Transportation (SFST) personnel, AOS hereby withdraws the above referenced application for the AOS Transport Packaging System.

AOS is submitting this withdrawal request with the intent of revising the application to include the additional information as requested by the NRC technical review staff for completion of the Safety Evaluation Report and draft Certificate of Compliance (CoC). AOS believes that a revised application will enable the NRC personnel to complete the technical review and generate the Safety Evaluation Report and draft CoC in a timely manner.
