10/2/2008 10:00 Mr. Kincaid indicated that the sources are used to deionize the air within the "pod" to decrease arcing. Each source is between 4 and 4.5 microcuries. The licensee is not required to possess survey instruments but does have two Ludlum Model 3 with 43-2 probes. The manufacturer calibrates them annually. The licensee possesses leak test kits in case it is determined that a sealed source is damaged. The upper management person to address documentation of the inspection is Mark Burnside, Site Manager.

10/21/2008 13:20 I spoke with Mr. Kincaid about the facsimile dated October 6, 2008. I noted the survey instruments were calibrated electronically and checked for functionality and determine a correction factor with a Plutonium-239 or thorium check source. Since the license does not require that the licensee have survey meters, this method of calibration is appropriate. I questioned Mr. Kincaid about the statement in the facsimile that physical inventories are conducted annually when the licensee's application states that they are to be performed every six months. Mr. Kincaid stated that the statement about annual physical inventories was an error. They are performed every six months and the misstatement was the result of following the same format as the previous sentence about the calibration of survey meters. I thanked Mr. Kincaid for the information.
