In our August 8, 2008 letter, (Ref. 1), AREVA NC Inc. reiterated to the NRC its intention to submit a separate, stand-alone Environmental Report (ER) ahead of the remainder of a license application for the construction and operation of a gas centrifuge uranium enrichment facility. This proposed facility has been designated the Eagle Rock Enrichment Facility (EREF). The August 8, 2008 AREVA letter also notified the NRC that we planned to submit the early, stand-alone ER in October 2008.

The NRC responded to our August 8, 2008 letter by letter dated October 8, 2008 (Ref. 2). The NRC letter stated that an exemption from 10 CFR 51.60, "Environmental Reports—materials, licensees," paragraph (a) would be necessary for the NRC to initiate an acceptance review and docketing of a standalone ER.

The purpose of this letter is to notify the NRC that AREVA is now planning to submit the ER together with the remainder of the license application for the construction and operation of the EREF. Accordingly, there is no longer any need to request an exemption to submit a separate ER. AREVA now intends to submit a complete license application by the end of December 2008
