As 90 days period for the NRC Staff' docking review is drawing to close, and a docking decision may be imamate, Dr. Jacob D Paz like to know whether the NRC staff's docking decision will include a written reply to the issues which Dr. Paz has raised in its June 2008, and the supplement information of July 27, 2008, questioning whether the Yucca Mountain License Application is completed?
