
Dear Sir or Madam:

Riverview Hospital would like to amend its Byproduct Materials License, Number 13-16286-01, to add Eric E. Beltz, M.D. as an Authorized User of materials licensed under 10 C.F.R. 35.100, 200, and 300 (limited to the use of sodium iodide-131 in quantities less than or equal to 33 milliCuries). Dr. Beltz is currently listed as an Authorized User on U.S.N.R.C. license number 13-32258-01.

In addition, we request the removal from the license of the authorization for uranium (depleted in uranium-235). The Authorized Use of the uranium is for use as shielding in an ADAC Laboratories Attenuation Correction Model MCD/AC Device. All the depleted uranium that fell under this authorization has been properly disposed of and we do not anticipate acquiring any in the future.
