Tony : I looked at the eggs in question and they both had late embryos in them. Although the pigmentation on the late embryos resembles that found on Rock bass yolk-sac larvae, there is very little pigmentation on Rock bass embryos inside the egg. The pigmentation pattern more closely resembles that which is found in Cyprinidae eggs (Taxon 228). I have changed the data sheet here in Bedford, so you should change the data there as well. If you have any other concerns please e-mail or call me, I will be happy to look into it.





