Enclosed is Amendment No. 68 of your NRC Material License No. 21-00182-03 in accordance with your letter dated July 9, 2008, requesting the NRC approve the release of the Pfizer Building 267 located in Kalamazoo, Michigan for unrestricted use, and to delete this location from your license as a place of use. Based on our review of the documentation you submitted in support of the request, we have determined that you have satisfactorily demonstrated that the Pfizer Building 267 at 333 Portage Street, Kalamazoo, Michigan does not contain residual radiological contamination in excess of NRC release limits. As a result, Building 267 can be released for unrestricted use.

The NRC staff prepared an Environmental Assessment (EA) and Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) regarding your proposed amendment to release the Pfizer facility for unrestricted use. An announcement was made in the Federal Register dated November 5, 2008, related to the EA and FONSI.
