This is in further response to your June 27, 1986 letter to S. A. White regarding outside evaluations and reports concerning TVA safety-related activities and management.

On September 11, 1986, you were notified that TVA had made special arrangements to make the Institute of Nuclear Power Operations (INPO) documentation pertaining to TVA available for NRC review at each TVA nuclear plant site and at TVA's Washington, D.C., Chattanooga, and Knoxville offices. We also indicated that the special arrangements would be terminated on December 31, 1986.

From discussions with your staff, we now understand that NRC wants the special arrangements continued beyond December 31, 1986. Therefore, the INPO documents will be available for NRC's review indefinitely. Once "the special nature of the current TVA situation," as stated in your June 27, 1986 letter no longer exists, TVA will discontinue these special arrangements.

Also, as shown on the enclosure, please note an address correction to the location of the INPO documents in Knoxville.
