Dear Sirs:

I oppose the Generic Draft Environmental Impact Statement for In-Situ Leach Uranium Milling Facilities. My ranch has an easement road running about 50 yards away from our ranch house, where trucks and other uranium hauling equipment would travel to forest service property beyond our ranch. I fear that milling and uranium operations would also disrupt and taint our well near proposed uranium operations. Our grandchildren living nearby may be jeopardized regarding their future health by uncontrolled situations connected with uranium extractions.

Please consider the impact uranium mining would pose for our ranching operation. Also, next to the access road is a large Indian overhanging shelter with numerous petroglyphs, which such operations would certainly taint and probably damage.
