Enclosed is one copy of the Final Report for the August 27, 2008, Radiological Emergency Preparedness (REP) Partial Participation Plume Exposure Pathway Exercise for the Quad Cities Nuclear Power Station. Under separate cover, three copies of this report are being sent to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Disaster Assistance and Preparedness Chief for distribution to the counties of Rock Island and Whiteside along with an additional copy for the State. The State of Illinois, Rock Island and Whiteside Counties, and the utility owner/operator, Exelon Nuclear, participated in this exercise.

No Deficiencies and no Areas Requiring Corrective Action were identified during this drill.

Based on the results of the August 27, 2008, exercise, the offsite radiological emergency response plans and preparedness for the State of Illinois and affected local jurisdictions, site-specific to the Quad Cities Nuclear Power Station, can be implemented and are adequate to provide reasonable assurance that appropriate measures can be taken offsite to protect the health and safety of the public in the event of a radiological emergency at the site.

Therefore, the Title 44 CFR, Part 350, approval of the offsite radiological emergency response plans and preparedness for the State of Illinois site-specific to the Quad Cities Nuclear Power Station, granted on March 2, 1984, remains in effect.
