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Dear Sir or Madam:

The referenced letter transmitted a request by Indiana Michigan Power Company for Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) approval of a proposed alternative to American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME) Code requirements and approval of an associated license amendment for Donald C. Cook Nuclear Plant Unit 2. As described in Enclosure 1 to the referenced letter, the proposed alternative to ASME Code Requirements involved volumetric examination of reactor vessel pressure retaining welds. As described in Enclosure 2 to the referenced letter, the proposed amendment would add a condition to the Unit 2 operating license requiring submittal of information and analyses to the NRC following the examination of the reactor vessel pressure retaining welds. The description in Section 2 of Enclosure 2 to the referenced letter indicated that the proposed license condition would be designated as item (ee) in Section 2.C(3) of the Unit 2 operating license. However, that designation has been used by a previous amendment. The license condition proposed in the referenced letter will therefore be designated as item (ff) in Section 2.C(3) of the Unit 2 operating license, rather than item (ee). The other information provided in the referenced letter is unaffected by the change in license condition designation.

The enclosure to this letter provides an affirmation statement. Copies of this letter and its attachments are being transmitted to the Michigan Public Service Commission and Michigan Department of Environmental Quality, in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 50.91 in the control of the
