
Quantity and Type: Class A radioactive waste in the form of dry activity material (paper coveralls, vinyl gloves, cotton rags, bubble suits, metal shavings and rejected parts) contaminated with Cobalt-60, Cobalt-58, Iron-59, and Manganese-54. The maximum total activity level shall not to exceed 0.000070 TBq (approximately 2mCi) and the maximum total volume of dry activity material in one 55-gallon drum shall not exceed 60 kilograms.

End Use: The contaminated waste materials resulted from the refurbishment of reactor coolant pump internals, which were exported from the D.C. Cook Nuclear Plant to AREVA JSPM in France. This waste is to be returned from France to the United States directly to the U.S. Receiving Facility (EnergySolutions, Tennessee). The waste resulting from processing in Tennessee will be shipped to the EnergySolutions Clive, Utah facility for disposal.
